Skills Bootcamps – Wave 3 Summary

- DfE contract running from August 2022 March 2023- 1M
- Target is for a minimum 240 learners to have completed Skills Bootcamps
- Framework agreement with 8 providers (4 local & 4 national companies)
- Sectors include: Digital, Construction, Green Skills Retrofit, Green Skills Arboriculture & Farming, Logistics, Leadership & Management (total of 14 Skills Bootcamps)
- To date achieved over 240 learners with a stretched target of 280
- Additional 'FLEX' awarded for a further 42 learners.



Skills Bootcamps – Wave 3 Digital Landscape

- Anicca L5 Digital Marketing (DMI) Target 58
 - Cohort 1 16 learners (11 self-employed, 5 seeking employment)
 - Cohort 2 27 learner (due to complete 09.03)
 - Cohort 3 15 re-allocation to commence 27.01
- Netmatters Web Development Target 25
 - 2 completed, 2 interviews and 2 into employment
 - Last 6 learners employee upskilling
- CoGrammar/HyperionDev Software Engineering Coding Target 30
 - National Contract
 - Cohorts didn't commence till Nov/Dec
 - 24 learners onboarded
 - Not familiar with local employers

Skills Bootcamps – Wave 4

- DFE contract awarded April 2023 2024
- 1.4M with option to request additional if business demands identified
- Tender live deadline 17th February 2023
- Pathways to Accelerated Apprenticeships
 - Piloted and successful with Digital
- Skills Bootcamps will come under Ofsted inspection from April 2023
- Aim Extending out to include more sectors Technical Core skills, legacy Health & Social Care



Skills Bootcamps – Wave 4 – Digital landscape

- Target 322
 - Front load 50% by September 23
 - Currently 60 allocated to Digital
- Dynamic purchasing system (DPS) Digital providers
- East of England 80 Digital entries –approx. 24 providers

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Skills Bootcamps aims and objectives

- To deliver flexible training programmes lasting from 60 hours and up to 16 weeks, based on employer / sector 'in-demand' skills needs
- To address the needs of adults (19+) who are full-time and part-time employed, unemployed, returning to work after a break or self-employed
- Training can be either regulated (i.e. qualification based) or non-regulated (e.g. based on alignment with industry standards)
- Enabling adults to do training around work and other commitments
- Developed for those looking to gain work, additional responsibilities, or access new opportunities and provide individuals with wider access to opportunities to retrain, update or formalise their skills or acquire specialist skills









Skills Bootcamps aims and objectives

- To address the needs of employers and the wider economy, to deliver targeted interventions to meet short-medium term demand to fill vacancies and drive productivity.
- They will help fill medium-higher level vacancies and bring individuals closer to better
 jobs, by linking them with line of sight to a job/ different role, additional responsibilities or
 new opportunities/contracts
- Offer a guaranteed job interview, in the case of a new job, to individual participants on completion of the course.
- To ensure that training is available in areas of the country that stand to benefit from the skills bootcamp model where provision isn't available or is limited.
